Literacy and English

Read

Engaging with peers and responding appropriately with feedback in book groups and the class novel, using contributions to build on our own thinking.

Identifying and discussing the purpose, main ideas and supporting detail contained within a text, using this information for different purposes.

Write

Focus: - Imaginative Writing

In both short and extended texts, using appropriate punctuation, varying sentence structures and dividing work into paragraphs in a way that makes sense to the reader.

Using language and style in a way which engages and/or influences the reader.

Listen and Talk

Speaking appropriately in class, and recognising when to speak in a group and or class setting.

Show understanding of what is listened to, or watched, by responding to literal, inferential, evaluative and other types of questions. Ask and create own kinds of questions from a text or programme.

Numeracy and Maths

- Use knowledge of rounding to routinely estimate the answer to a problem then, after calculating, decide if my answer is reasonable, sharing my solution with others. Rounding whole numbers to the nearest 1000, 10 000 and 100 000.
- Partition a wide range of whole numbers and decimal fractions.
- Adds and subtracts multiples of 10, 100 and 1000 to and from whole numbers and decimal fractions to two decimal places.
- Problem Solving - interpret questions successfully in order to work out solutions.

Health and Wellbeing

- I am aware of and able to express my feelings and am developing the ability to talk about them
- Identify ways in which to stay focused on a task.
- Growth Mindset lessons - discussing the value of feedback and what is important to us as learners.
- Increase stamina by running the Daily Mile.

Respect

A programme lasting over 6 sessions aimed at encouraging young people to develop healthy relationships, promoting self respect and respect for others, and respect for difference. Challenging and decreasing tolerance of violence among young people and encouraging a sense of social responsibility.
