Do your homework!

- Spelling & numeracy worksheets (try the percentages one if you finish the tables/division)
- Prepare your book talk. If school is still shut tomorrow we will simply have them another day so be prepared!
- Read a book! Consider reading to a younger sibling, pet or an adult and use expression to make the story more exciting

Numeracy:

- There is a new Sumdog challenge for you to complete by the end of the week so just sign in! If you finish, go into your profile and choose specific skills to work on
- Practice your times tables

Literacy & Topic

- Imagine you are a passenger on board Titanic and write a diary entry from some point of your journey (e.g. the night before you board, one of the days sailing) but **DO NOT** go past the point where the crew tell you that it is sinking... (As always, use your VCOP!)
- Research the Titanic, taking notes as you go

For BOTH tasks above, work can be done electronically if you want instead of on paper so consider using Sway/power-point/word document but make sure you put it in your OWN WORDS.

Additional work in case of further snow/total boredom...

- Imagine you are trapped in your house by the snow for 1 weeks. You are safe and having heating/water/cooking facilities but there is no WIFI or other internet signal and all your technology is broken!!!
 - o Create a list 5 different things you could do to entertain yourself - perhaps even try a few today!
 - o Make a shopping list of all the food (and quantities) you would need to feed 4 people for the week. Research the prices to calculate how much it will all cost!
- Research a picture of the Titanic and sketch your own version
- Make a model of the Titanic or one of the 1st class cabins using recycled things!
